Public Domain & Content Websites

I'd like to introduce you to a strategy I've been using over the past 2 months. It involves the use of Public Domain materials.

Here's a quick description of Public Domain. Public Domain refers to material that is free to use because it has lost its copyright protection. There are 100's of thousands, if not millions of public domain works available for use.

For a more thorough discussion of public domain, pick up a copy of this report by Dave Vallieres, [Public Domain Riches](#).

If you want to watch a quick video, a friend of mine, James Jones, put together a free video that's packed with information on how to research for [public domain materials](#).

Another source is Russel Brunsons "[The Lost Files](#)". This is a membership site, you get two fully researched public domain works per month, complete with all the necessary documentation to prove that it is in the public domain. You also get a sales page, graphics and the document in various formats, txt doc pdf.

First you're going to want to want to pick up a piece of software that converts the public domain .txt files into html pages. Don't worry its pretty cheap ☺ You can pick up a program called [Conversionary](#) for less than \$20, by Wendy Woudstra, who provides excellent support if needed.

The process of converting txt file into an html page is very simple. First you're going to want to create a template with an notepad or a wysiwyg editor like dreamweaver.

You'll create the template just like any other web page, but you'll insert small pieces of code that tell the Conversionary tool to insert the .txt at that location. The videos explain this concept further.

If you're familiar with "php includes" you'll be at a big advantage, then you can use the includes to pull in any type of file, text or photo. Imagine creating 200 versions of an intro paragraph with [ArticleBot](#). If you use a program like Traffic on Steroids, you can rotate those 200 articles into your content on any random basis.. the result being truly unique content.

Take it one step further. What if you used [ArticleBot](#) to create some very eye friendly scrapes, why not use the php includes generated by Traffic on Steroids to rotate the scrapes.

You're really limited to your imagination, with the [Conversionary](#) program, [Article Bot](#) and a program like Traffic on Steroids.

The next set of videos in this series will deal with using Traffic on Steroids to rotate any number of files in the location of one php include.

I'll take the document we just worked with and do the following:

Create, add, and rotate 100 Article Bot created introduction paragraphs around the theme of gardening.

Create 5 or 10 rss feeds that focus on the subject of gardening and rotate them from one php include

Create and rotate an rss feed for clickbank and one for Amazon

Purpose

Remember my purpose is singular and focused. Create a site that has unique content, randomly refreshed content and can be monetized in more than one way.

While doing that, I sincerely want to the site to be of value to the visitor and be attractive to the search engine spiders.

I might be living in a dream world, but this is one mans plan and method at the moment. As with anything and everything on the internet, what works today might not work tomorrow. You have to get to the point where you understand this, with that understanding you'll have the wisdom to move forward.

Next Series

The next series of videos will be the most important. Up until now we've learned the basics. The abc's if you will. In the last series of video we'll introduce an additional form of content, plus tie everything together. The result will be a super slick, constantly changing site that will be totally under your control.

Resources

Remember, these are all tools and techniques that I'm using. I'm not just trying to get you to buy some program so I can make a \$10 commission. Get real☺ I could be spinning sites. I enjoy sharing and teaching others what I know. I'm far from an expert and as you read this, it may all be very elementary to you. Simply put, this is for the guy or gal who would like to get started and is slightly confused or simply looking for direction. The Public Domain option is an easy way to get content up quickly, and explore some of the ways to monetize your site. Practice with the PD stuff, and when your ready, I guarantee your AB sites will look a lot better. It certainly seems as though Google now values the way your site looks, like it or not, its your decision.

[Membership to the Lost Files](#) is closing July 15, 2005. I highly recommend this program. You get two public domain books that are not works that can be yanked off the internet. They come complete with a professional sales page, graphics and all kinds of goodies.

I believe you can still take it for a \$1.00 test run for 3 days, download whats there and cancel if you don't think its worth it.

By learning and understanding the techniques I've introduced in this series, you can apply them in the construction of any website, in particular, ArticleBot. The best way I've found to implement these techniques is to apply one to a page (not a whole site) upload it, see if it works and how it looks, mess around with it until you understand it.
